Donation 101... Making your donation count

We are **Unable** to Accept the Following Items:

Unfortunately, there are certain items we can't take for reasons of liability, health issues or disposal costs. Remember, when putting donations together we accept re-usable and re-sellable items.

- **Appliances: washers, dryers, refrigerators, stoves, mini frigs
- Automotive: auto parts, tires, batteries, mufflers
- Baby equipment: due to recalls and liability issues, baby gates, car carriers, car seats, cribs, playpens, swing sets
- Broken, damaged, stained, un-cleaned, non-working items
- Clothes hangers
- **Construction Materials/Equipment: lumber, wood, paint, wall to wall carpet or padding, venetian or vertical blinds, light fixtures, doors, tubs, cabinets, pipes, wheelbarrows, yard tools
- **Electronic Equipment: computers, faxes, monitors, towers, printers, TV's, televisions, console type TV/stereos
- Exercise equipment including weights
- **Flammable/Hazardous Products: BBQ's, batteries, chemicals, cleaning products, gas cans, paint, propane containers, gas lawn mowers or trimmers, weapons, ammunition
- Food (Contact Northwest Harvest (800) 722-6924)
- Furniture that is torn, stained, or broken. Hide-abeds, bean bag chairs, bunk beds, futons or futon frames, box springs, mattresses, waterbeds, bed frames, coil springs
